


**WEEE POSITION STATEMENT**

Directive 2002/96/EC, or WEEE (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment), was authorized in January 2003 along with RoHS. This Directive encourages and sets specific criteria for the collection, handling and recycling of electric and electronic waste. Manufacturers became responsible for compliance to the WEEE Directive on August 13, 2005.

WEEE applies to electronic and electrical equipment (EEE) which falls within 10 categories identified in Schedule 1 of the WEEE regulations. LS Research RF modules currently available for sale in Europe must be integrated into finished goods applications, and therefore do not meet the criteria for required compliance to the WEEE Directive.
